- There should be two types of membership
 - Company
 - o Individual
- Company members will have one "vote" in elections and are able to have one designated employee
- Individual members may associate their membership with a Company member, but this
 is not required

- Listed in the Membership Directory
- Can serve on Committees
- Can vote in National elections
- Member agrees to NSITSP code of ethics
